Happy Hills Orchard




Happy Hills Orchard

Happy Hills Orchard is a happy little orchard where the little cherries live, learn and have fun! There are lots of little cherries in the orchard and each little cherry is different. Find out about all of the little cherries in each book.

But What is an Orchard?

An Orchard is an area of land where fruit trees are grown. The Happy Hills Orchard grows cherry trees but an orchard can grow lots of different fruit trees. Fruit trees can also grow in a garden, a park or woodlands. But it is only an orchard when there are lots of fruit trees growing together.

Activity: Orchards can grow different types of fruits. Try some different fruits that may grow in an orchard and see which ones you prefer. You could even make an apple crumble or baked pear.














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This is Drupe. They are the main character in Drupe's Busy Day.

- Drupe is a red cherry with a bendy green stalk. They have blue glasses, a pink checked scarf and a walking stick.
- Drupe loves to look after other people and make them happy. This means they are very busy.
- Drupe is so busy helping other people that they are very tired themselves and need to rest.
- Drupe's friends show them that it is okay to take time to relax and look after themselves. This is just as important as helping other people.







Engagement Activities




Activity 1: It's Nice to be Nice




Activity 2: Time to Bake

Drupe enjoys baking cakes. What is your favourite cake?

Plan your cake decoration below and draw a picture of what it should look like. Then finally, eat your cake with your friends and family!












Activity 3: Time for Yourself

Draw 5 activities you find calming and try and do one each day. It is great to take the time to look after yourself and make yourself feel happy.














Activity 4: Flowers

Flowers can make people smile as they look and smell lovely. Flowers can be all sorts of different shapes, sizes and colours. Go on a walk and take photos of your favourite flowers- can you learn the names of any?

When you get back, plant some seeds or bulbs to grow your own flowers. You could do this in a garden, window-box or even a plant for inside your house. Some flowers grow quickly and others take a long time. You will have to make sure you water your flowers and give them plenty of light to help them grow. Create a photo or sketch diary of how your flowers are growing over the next few weeks.

- Take some time as a family to sit and relax with a warm blanket and some cake, just like Drupe.









































